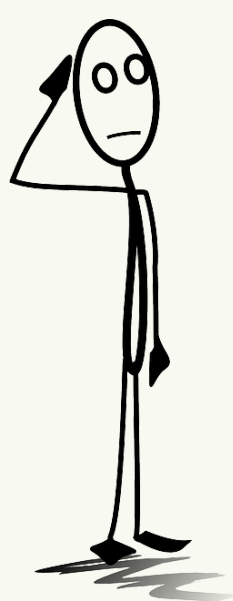


Fullness of Life

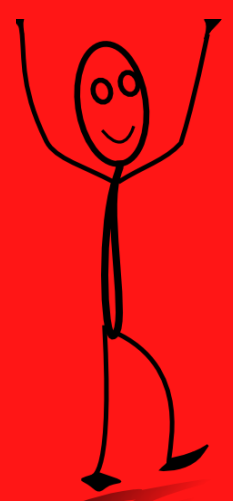
Discover Your True Identity
